

1. WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL?

The Constitution lays down the following qualifications for a person to be chosen as a member of the State Legislature.

He must be citizen of India.

He must not be less than 30 years of age.

He must possess other qualifications as prescribed by the Parliament.

He/she must be an elector for an assembly constituency in the concerned state and to be qualified for governor's nomination, he/she must be a residence in the concerned state.
