

**1. ELABORATE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AND LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WHERE THERE IS BICAMERAL SYSTEM.**

<b>Legislative Assembly</b>	<b>Legislative Council</b>
Minimum age is 25 years of age	Minimum age is 30 years of age
The term is 5 years	It is a permanent house not subject to dissolution
The strength limit is 60 – 500	The limit of the members is 40 to 1/3 of the total members of the assembly
Members are elected by direct election	Elected by indirect election
Both money bill and non-money bill can be initiated	Only non-money bill can be initiated
It can participate in the election of the president	It cannot
No-confidence Motion can be passed	No-confidence Motion cannot be initiated
It can pass a resolution for the creation and abolition of Legislative Council in the state	It cannot pass a resolution for the creation and abolition of Legislative Assembly in the state
It has the ultimate power of passing a money bill or a ordinary bill	It can retain a Money Bill for a maximum period of 14 days with its recommendations; in case of an ordinary bill it can detain or delay for a maximum period of four months.
